The broken lines in FIG. 1 are for illustrative purposes only.

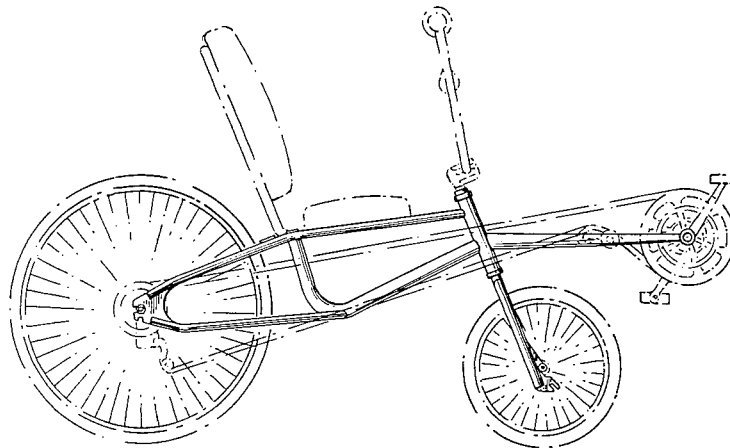
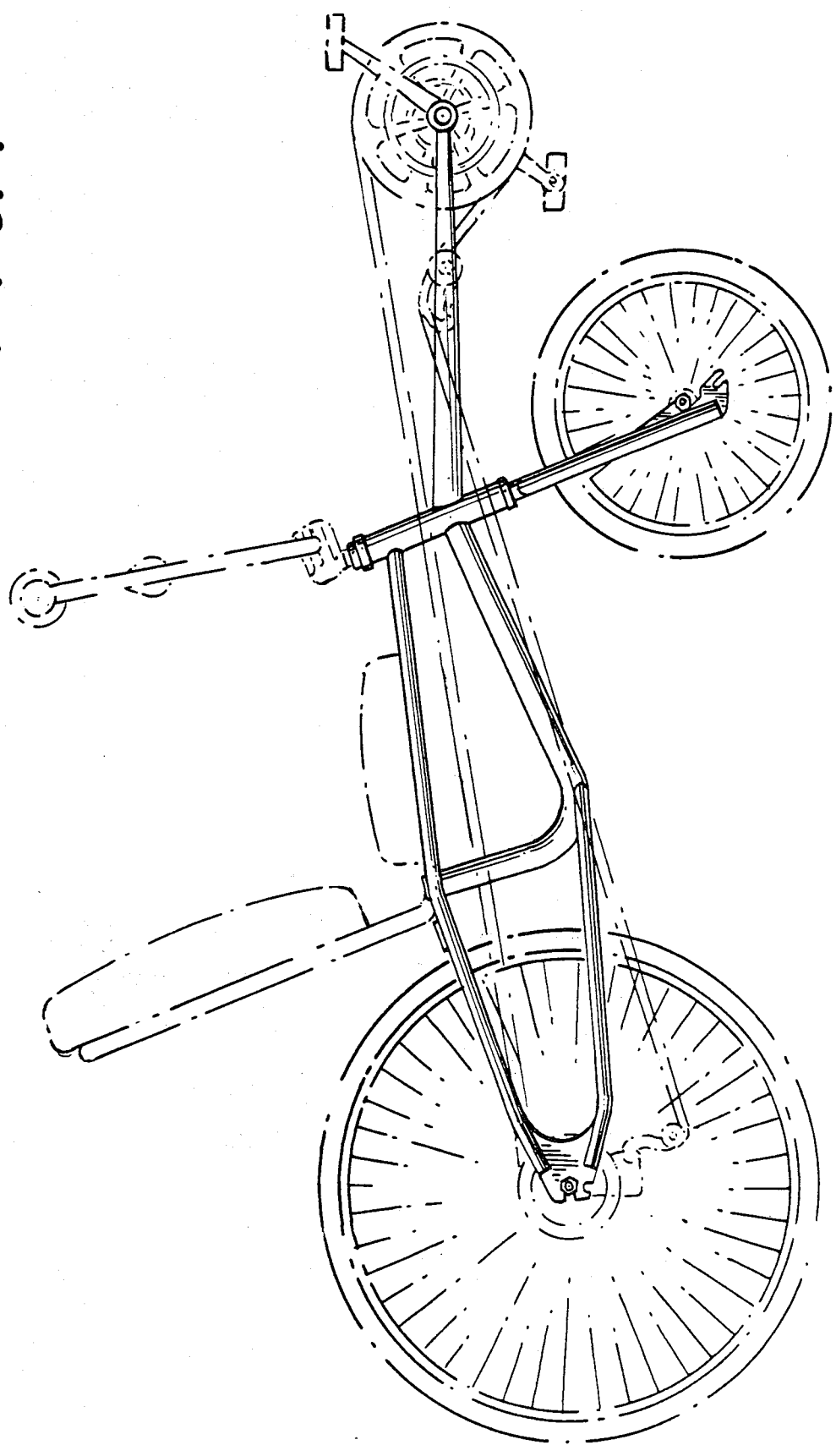

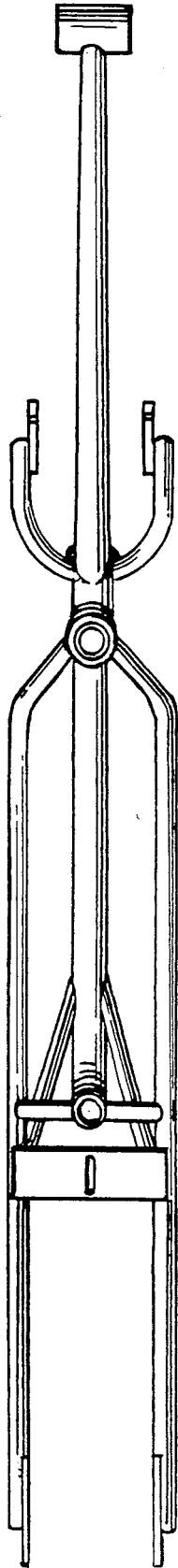

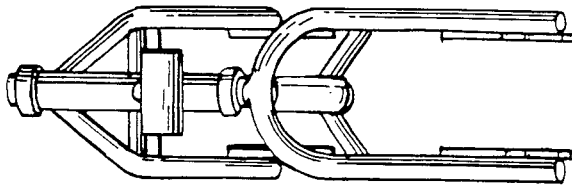

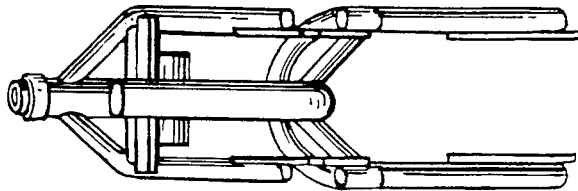
