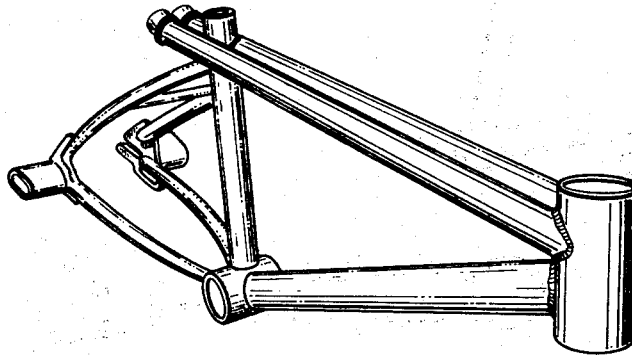

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of bicycle frame;
FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof with the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof.



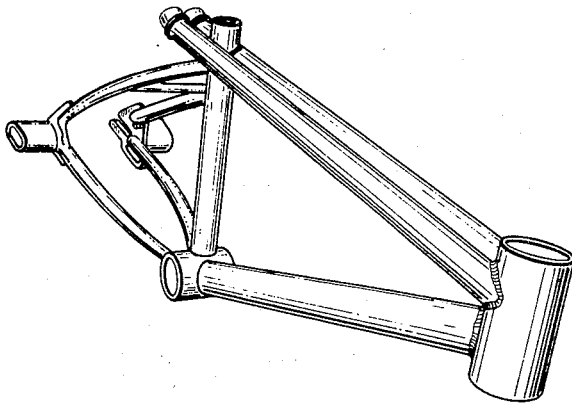

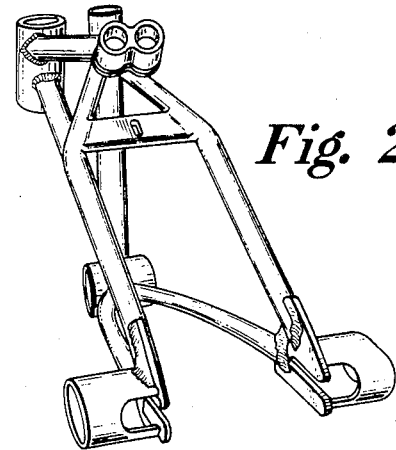

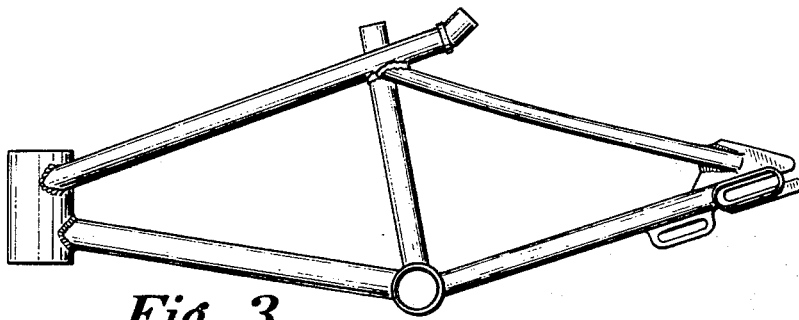

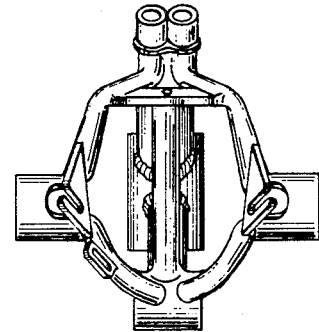

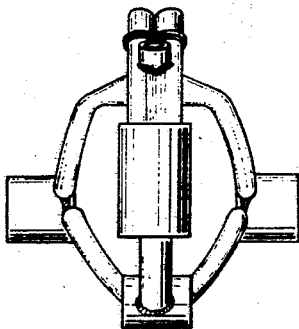

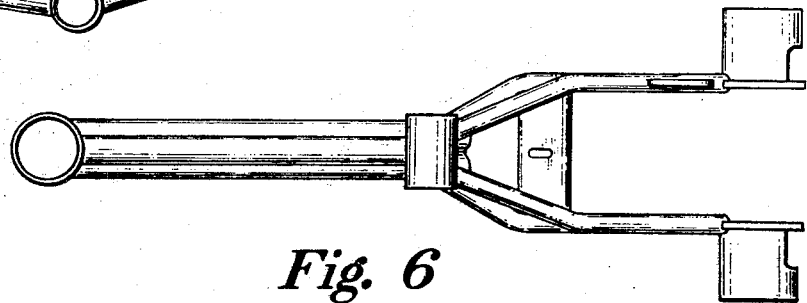

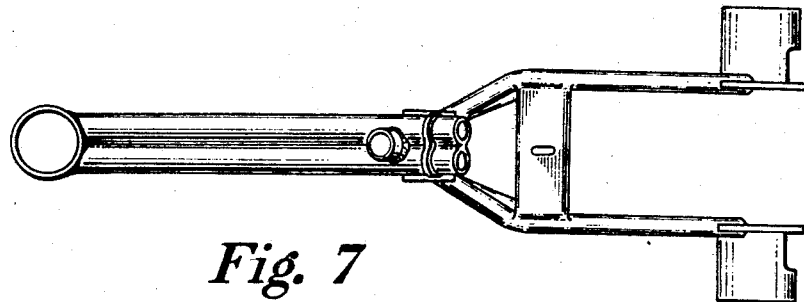
