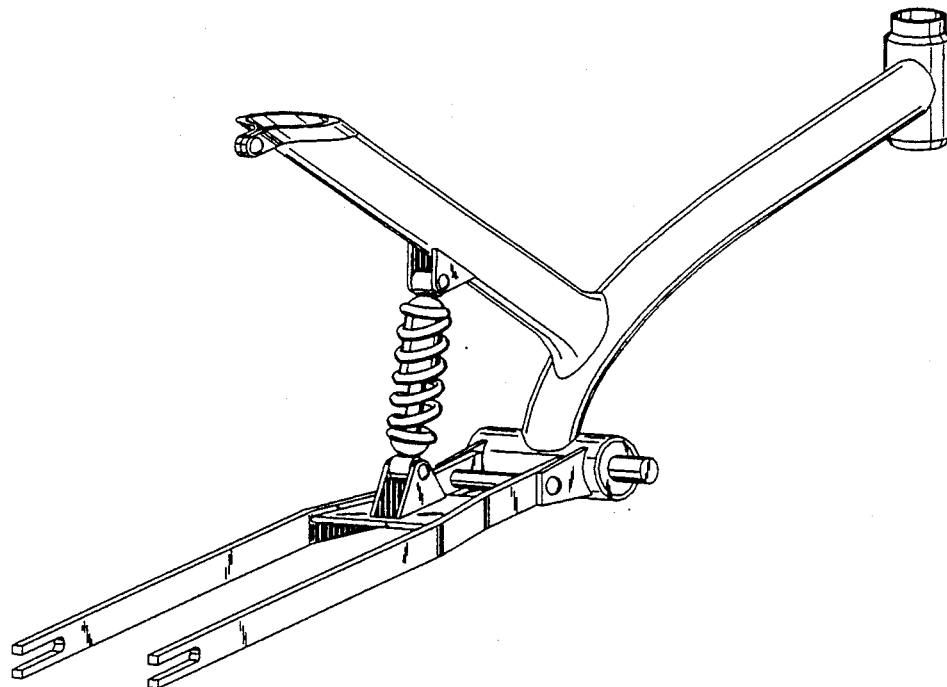

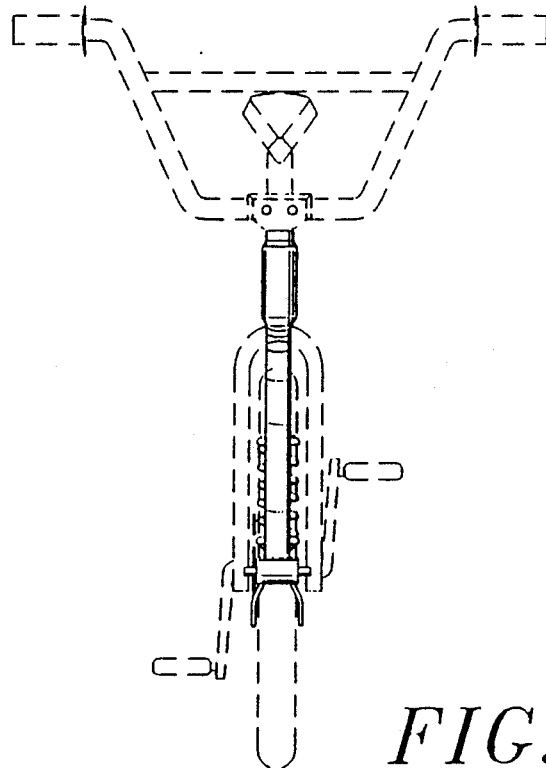
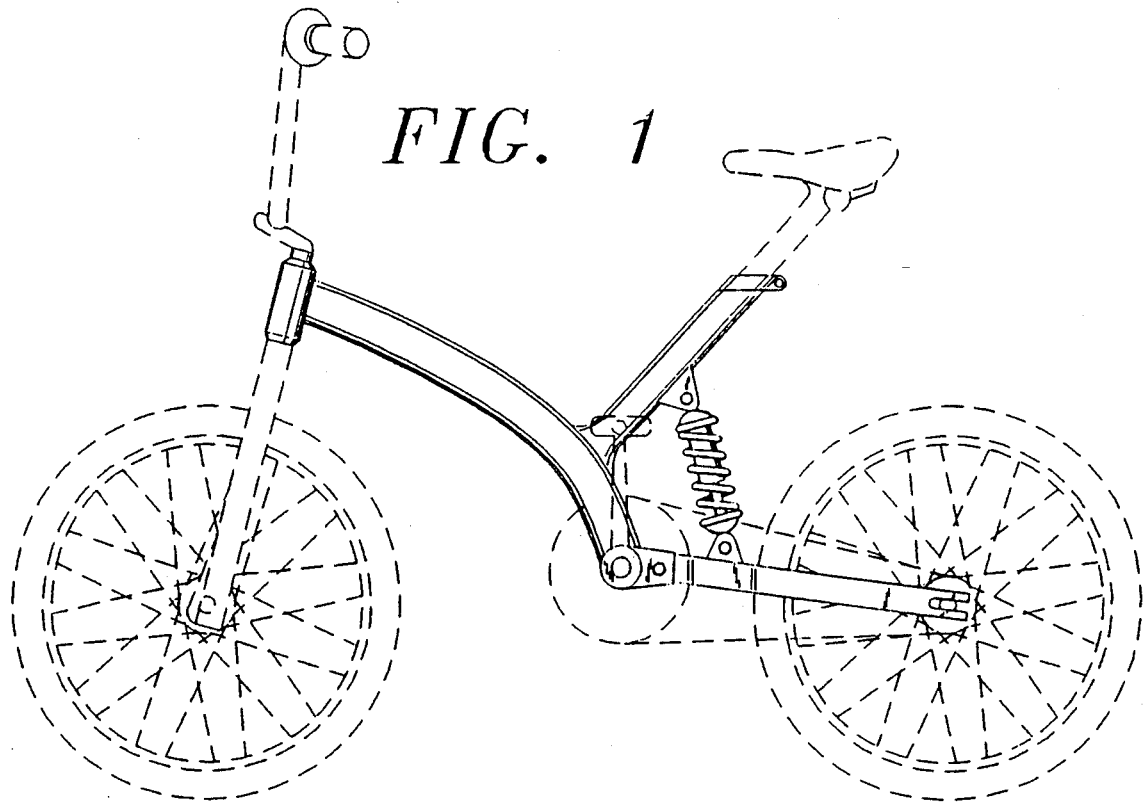

 The broken lines in FIGS. 1 and 2 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.





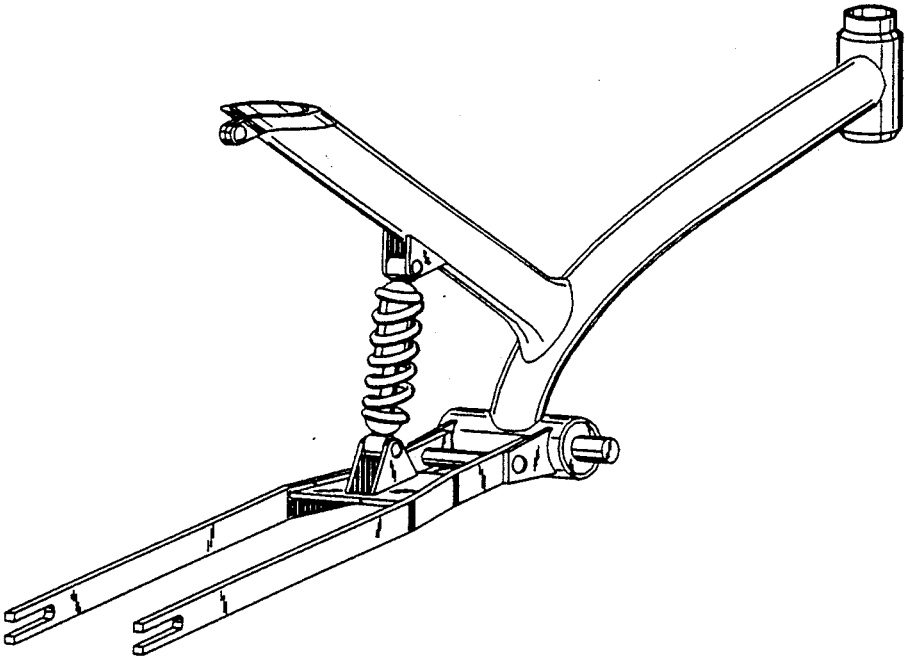

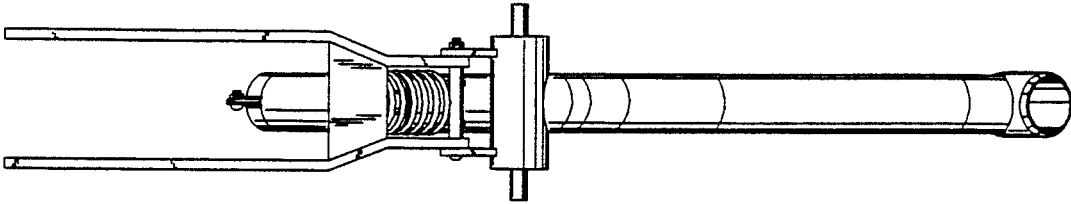
