FIG. 12;

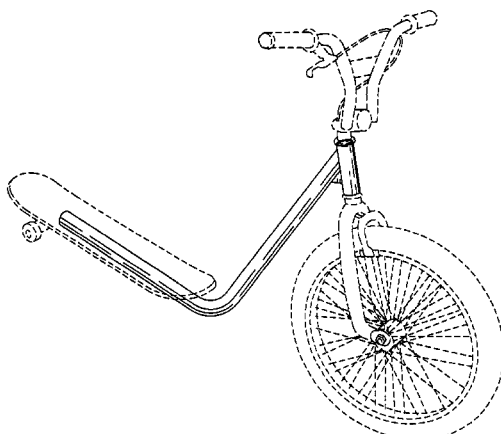
FIG. 14 is a right side view of the third embodiment shown

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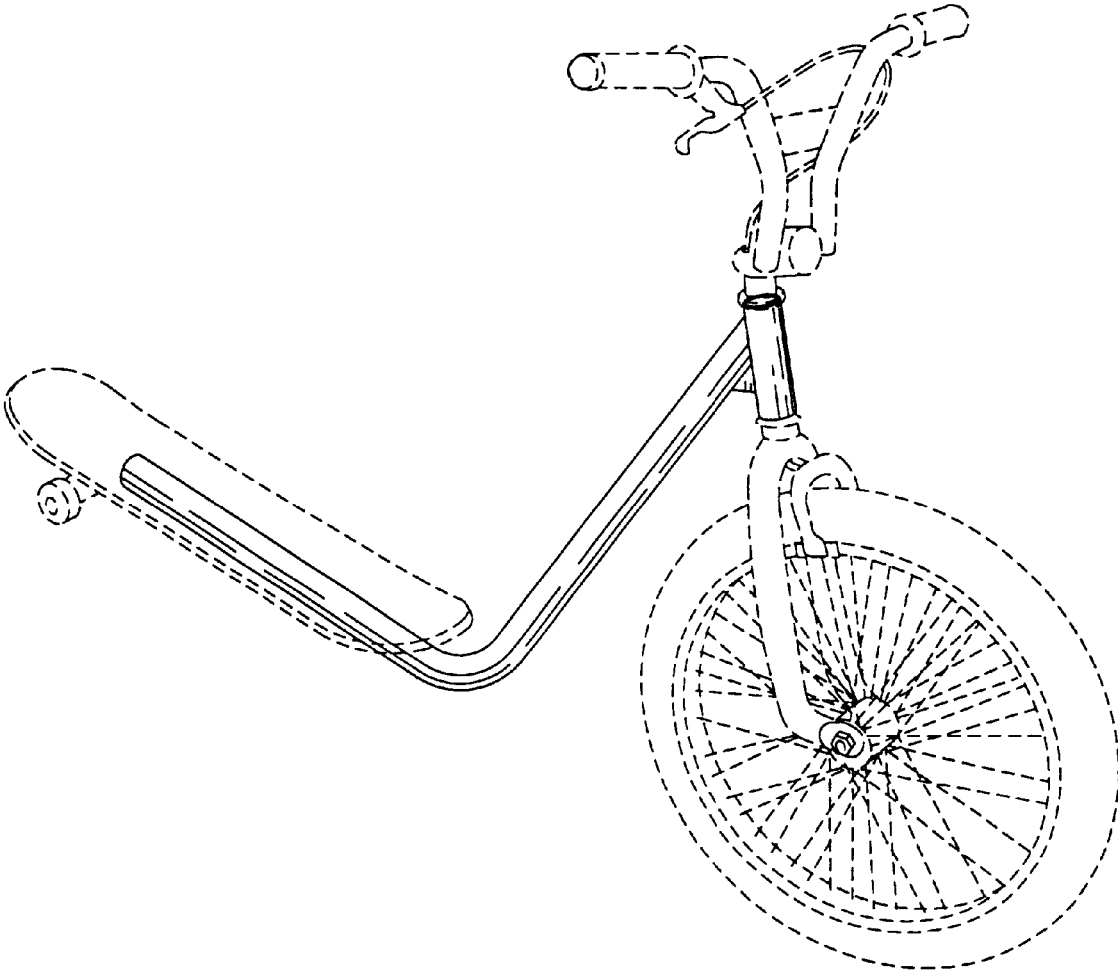

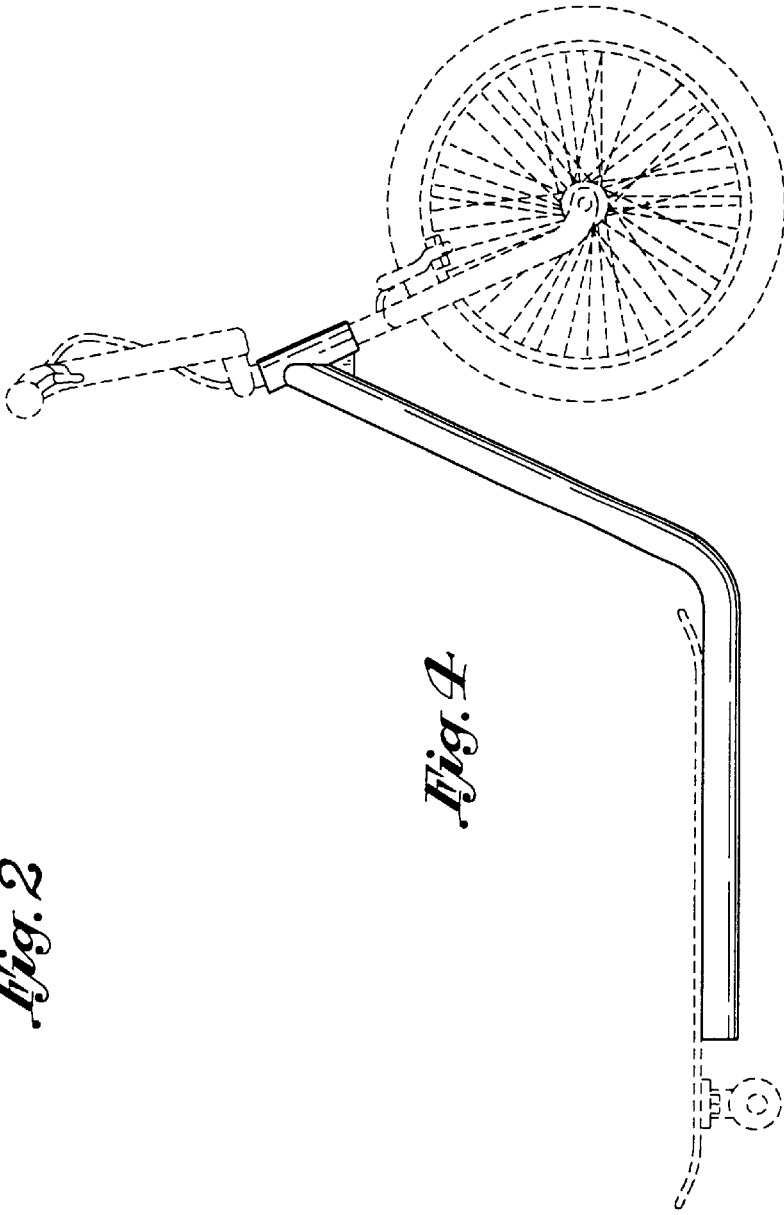
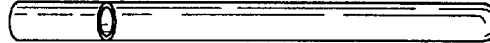

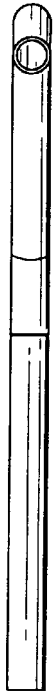

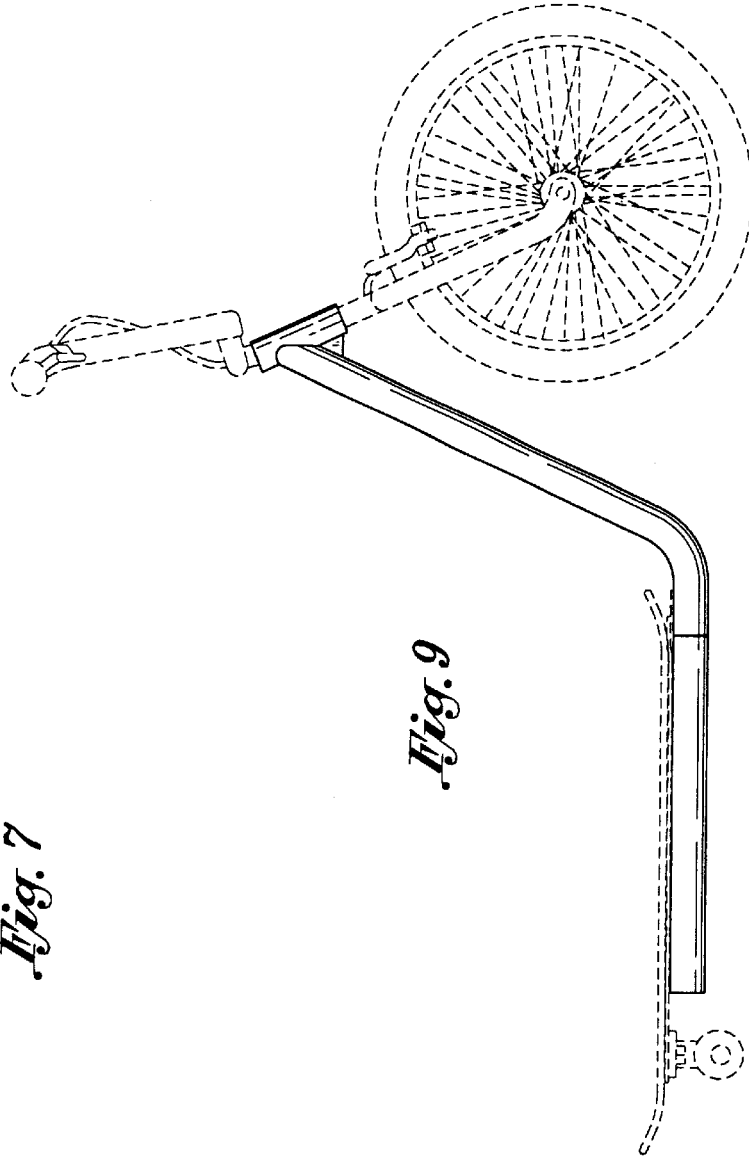

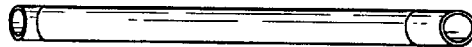

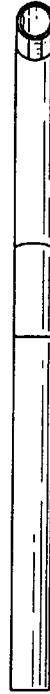

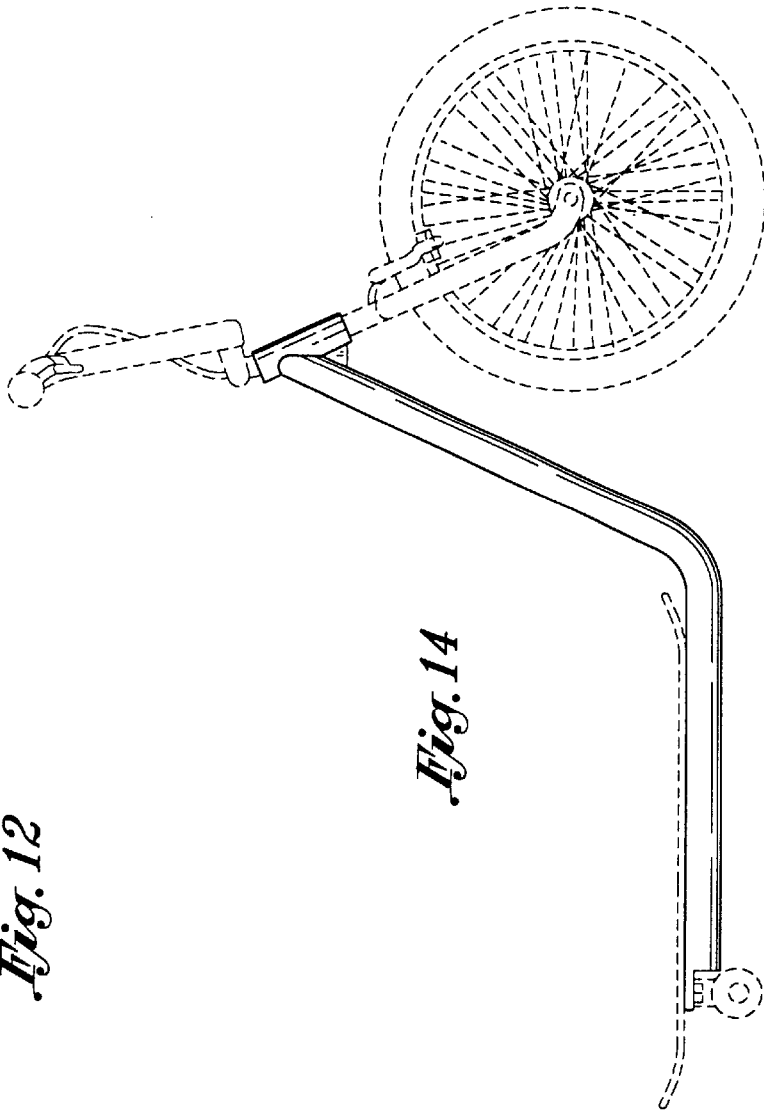

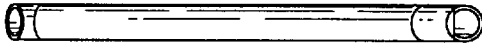

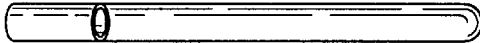
